1- What is the topic sentence of the first paragraph?

Narcolepsy is a disease characterized by malfunctioning sleep mechanics.

2- What is the thesis sentence of the whole passage?

The answer for this question depends on student's own point of view, only under one condition which is to write his view in a complete sentence. However, the best answer might be "Narcolepsy has two types each of which has its own symptoms".

3- According to the passage, what do the nighttime narcoleptics suffer from?

Nighttime narcoleptics may suffer from hallucinations that consist of realistic perceptions of sights and sounds during the semi-conscious state between wakefulness and sleep. Narcoleptics may also suffer from night wakening during sleep, resulting in extremely fragmented and restless sleep. Then, upon waking, a narcoleptic may experience sleep paralysis, the inability to move, perhaps for several minutes, immediately after waking.

4- What does the underlined word "Paralysis" mean?

Sleep **paralysis** means the inability to move, perhaps for several minutes, immediately after waking.

5- Give an appropriate title for the passage.

The answer for this question depends on student's own point of view, only under one condition which is to write his view in a short phrase or clause. However, the best answer might be "Narcolepsy Symptoms".
